



# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

## Accommodation

Removal of the restriction for certified accommodation providers to provide services to only fully vaccinated persons

Removal of the restrictions on sale of disposal of intoxicating liquor to non-vaccinated person for the consumption on licensed premises.





# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

FROM 2<sup>ND</sup> APRIL TO 29<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2022

## Travel

The Chief Medical Officer may not require a COVID-19 test from a national, resident or non-national arriving in Saint Lucia who is fully vaccinated if the fully vaccinated person produces a valid vaccination record.





# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

FROM 2<sup>ND</sup> APRIL TO 29<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2022

## Travel

Travel authorisation for entry into Saint Lucia remains suspended until further notice.

A fully vaccinated person who wishes to travel to Saint Lucia must upload to the designated portal, valid proof of his/her vaccination certificate/record.





# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

## Travel

An unvaccinated person who wishes to travel to Saint Lucia must upload onto the designated portal a valid negative PCR test to facilitate entry.





# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

## Travel

The Chief Medical Officer is not prevented from placing a person under quarantine at a quarantine facility or at his or her home in order to protect the health of the person or for public health.





# PROTOCOLS FOR OPERATING

FROM 2<sup>ND</sup> APRIL TO 29<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2022

## Travel

An unvaccinated person shall submit a valid negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test taken within five days prior to arrival in Saint Lucia.
